



How To Make Bird Teepees

Bird teepees are great enrichment for our bird residents. They also provide nice hiding places for them!

1. Get gloves and shears or loppers from shop
2. Wander around the sanctuary and find fir and cedar trees (not pine – they dry up too fast)
3. Cut 3-4 foot small branches
4. Remove old teepee materials and toss them into the woods somewhere.
You'll know they are old because they are brown and drying up. See photos below:







5. Build teepees in areas where you can prop the branches up against stumps, trees, corners of fencing, etc. Examples are below:
