



How To Make Popsicles for the Animals

Small Popsicles – for goats/sheep/pigs

1. Use small dixie cups



2. Put a small amount of fruit juice into cup





3. Add a few treats to cup (choose 1 option below)
 - a. Chopped produce
 - b. Crushed dog cookies
 - c. Goat Snax/other goat labeled treats



4. Fill rest of the cup with water
5. Freeze (they do best on a cookie sheet so they don't fall over in the freezer)





Medium Popsicles – for donkeys/llamas/alpacas

1. Use pint/deli containers
2. Put a small amount of fruit juice into container



3. Add a few treats to cup (choose 1 option below)
 - a. Chopped produce
 - b. Crushed dog cookies
 - c. Any of the treats labeled for horses
 - d. Small handful of hay

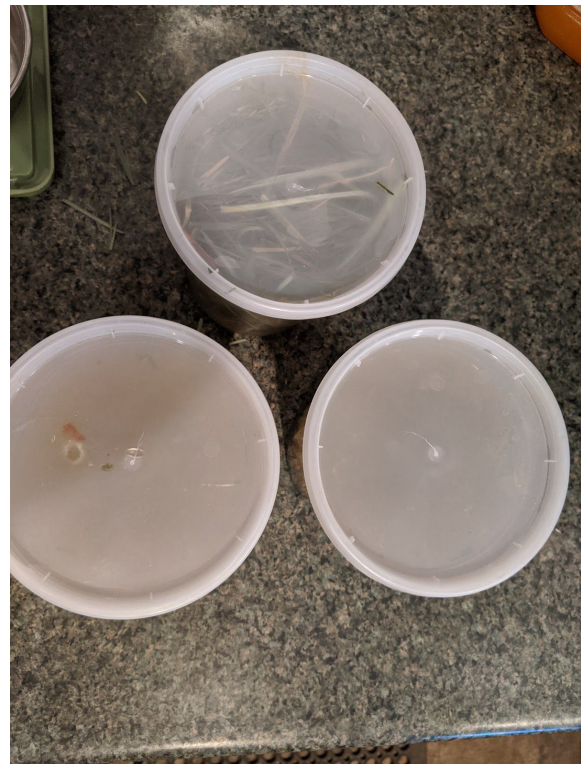




4. Fill rest of the cup with water



5. Cover with a lid



6. Freeze



Large Popsicles - for cows

1. Use plastic buckets (Halloween ones work well)
2. Put a small amount of fruit juice into bucket



3. Add a handful of treats
 - a. Chopped produce
 - b. Handful of hay
 - c. Leftover treat crumbs (in a ziplock bag on the shelf)
 - d. Ask caregiver for cow specific treats (kept out at the cow barn)





4. Fill bucket with water



5. Freeze (the buckets take up a lot of space in the freezer, so ask for help if there's no more room)
